

## How do I know if the Bible I am using is a fake? Where can I find more information?

There are many good resources out there proving how the KJV is head and shoulders over virtually all bible versions. I am not really familiar with a lot of the new bibles (they seem to spread like crabgrass!), but I can briefly share with you some benchmarks by which you can tell if a Bible is fake or not.

1) In your Bible, does 1 John 5:7 clearly proclaim the Trinity? If not, you have a BAD bible.

2) In your Bible, does Luke 2:43 call Joseph Jesus' father? If so, it is denying the virgin birth. Very BAD bible!

3) In Acts 4:27 is Jesus called a child or a servant? If only a servant, then it is bad (see also verse 30).

1) In Col. 1:14 is the blood mentioned? If not, you have a fake.

That should give you a start.

It is a huge book, but it just blows all the fake bibles out of the water and is a very valuable and scholarly resource for the Bible believer.
