Also, the study NOTES in the Bible frequently promote the Alexandrian cult line about the "oldest best manuscripts" and they cast doubt on the text. The dark and perverse influence of Westcott and Hort can be seen lurking in the notes on almost every page. It still elevates scholarship about faith in the Word.
