

I think I am cursed. How can I deal with this?

Well, please remember that the Bible says the curse does not come without a cause (**Prov. 26:2**). You should examine your life (I am assuming you are a Christian) and see if there are any "open doors" which might give the enemy access. These could include not tithing. But there could be other things.

- 1) Sins of your ancestors - these can be easily broken in prayer.
- 2) Ever worshipping false gods, this would include being in any false religions
- 3) Any involvement in the occult
- 4) All forms of oppression, injustice or cheating - especially when directed against the helpless, the poor or the weak.
- 5) All forms of fornication (illicit sex), homosexuality or other perversions
- 6) Anti-Semitism
- 7) Legalism, carnality or apostasy (false doctrine)
- 8) Theft or perjury
- 9) Withholding from the Almighty money to which He has a claim
- 10) Words spoken over you by people with relational authority over you (parents, teachers, clergy, etc.). This would include such people saying to you - especially as a child - things like "You will never amount to anything."
- 11) Self imposed curses through being bitter or unforgiving
- 12) Curses sent from servants of Satan for which there are open doors to allow them in
- 13) Soulsh talk directed against others (gossip, tale bearing, etc.)
- 14) Soulsh prayers that accuse or seek to control others (charismatic witchcraft)

Prayerfully examine yourself to see if you have been guilty of these things. If so, pray and ask YHWH to forgive you. Make amends if applicable. There is elsewhere on this site a free prayer you can download as a sample prayer to break curses.
